**Job Duties** J & E manages the Domestic Violence Offenders Program, a court ordered spousal/domestic partner abuse treatment program (the contract covers males only at this time) for Montgomery County, Maryland. We conduct 16-20 treatment groups per week (on weekday evenings and Saturdays) in addition to intake and individual counseling work. Each group has an independently licensed (in Maryland) leader and a co-leader. The groups are held in Silver Spring and Rockville and follow an established psycho-educational model in a 26-week program. Consultants also conduct intake assessments and do individual and some couples counseling.
